HOW YOU ARE GRADED

A - 100-90	Tests	50%	4 - 100

F - Below 60	Project	15%	0 - 40

Tests: At least one test will be given per unit. In addition to the current unit, each test could contain information from the previous unit as well.

Quiz: You can expect 2 or more quizzes per unit.

Homework: You can expect your homework to be checked for completion on a daily basis. They will utilize the 0-4 point grading scale.

Classwork: You can expect your classwork to be checked for correctness on a daily basis. You will be given a chance to do corrections in class. They will utilize the 0-4 point grading scale.

Project: There will be a project for every unit. You will be given a week to complete the project. Late projects will be accepted but with deductions.

TARDY POLICY

IF YOU ARE ABSENT
